



Let's Chat Challenge

How well do you really know your friends and family?! Find out with this fun and easy game you can play with people near or far. These questions are also great for family dinner conversation starts.

GAME RULES

This is our family's go-to game when we gather – whether it's under the same roof or miles apart (via telephone or video conferencing). You need paper and pen and a minimum of 4 players – the more the merrier!

- 1 A person poses a question to the group. This question can be one of our Let's Chat questions or one they make up on their own.
- 2 Each person in the group secretly writes down their answer to the question (or texts to an agreed upon group member).
- 3 A group members reads all the answers to the question without revealing who wrote them.
- 4 The person who asked the question then tries to match each answer with a person.
- 5 Points are awarded for every match.
- 6 The role of questioner then rotates to another person and the original questioner becomes part of the group that answers.

Example:

The questioner might ask, "What famous living person would you like to have lunch with?" Answers from the group might be Michelle Obama, Stephen Curry, Beyonce, Tom Hanks or Dolores Huerta.

SAMPLE QUESTIONS

Here are some sample questions to get you started. The more unusual the questions, the more engaging the game!

- If you could be a part of any fictional universe, which one would you choose?
- If you were a bird, where would you fly to?
- If you could choose any animal to be your friend, what would you choose?
- If you could be invisible for one day, what would you do?
- What do you like to bake or cook?
- What are you grateful for?
- What is your favorite activity to do?
- What is hardest for you to say?
- If you create a costume for your family, what would they wear?
- Would you rather hug a zombie, ghost or werewolf?
- If you were to write a book, what would it be about?
- What is your favorite activity to do with your family?
- If you could talk with animals, what would you say to them? What you would you ask?
- What is your favorite thing about yourself?
- How would you like to change the world?
- What is one thing you cannot live without?
- If you could have any job, what would it be?
- What famous person would you like to be friends with?
- What super power would you like to have?
- What time in history would you most like to visit?
- If you could live in any other place, where would it be?
- What's your favorite movie?
